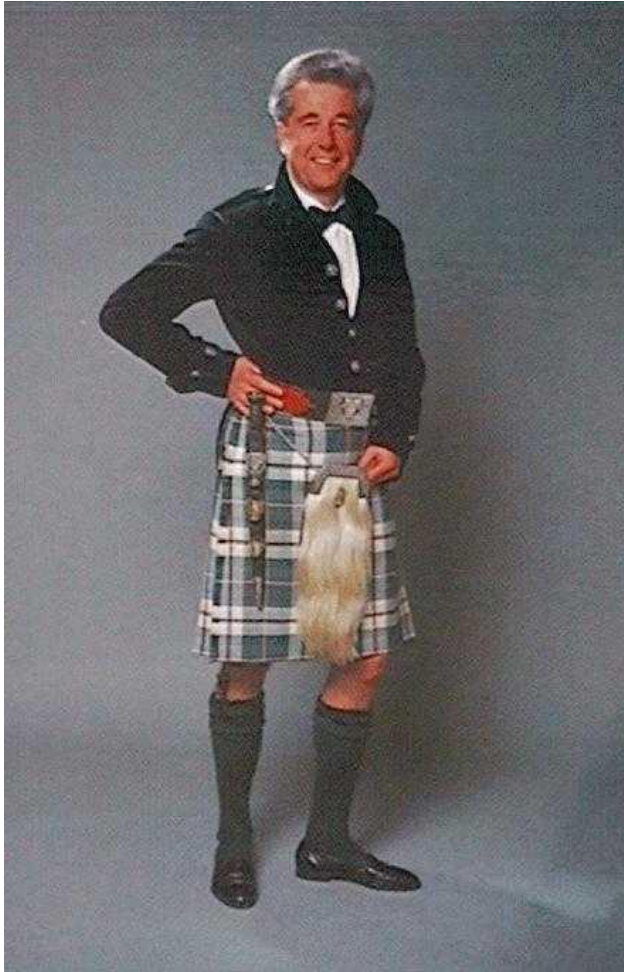

Chief John MacLeod of MacLeod died at the age of 71 during the night of the 12 February 2007. (Tuesday our time)

The 29th chief of the Clan MacLeod, who succeeded his grandmother Dame Flora MacLeod as chief in 1976, died after a battle against leukaemia. He had been hospitalised for the past 6 weeks.
